

Further ENhancing the Implementation of Quality Standards in drug demand reduction across Europe (FENIQS-EU)

Laboratory for Prevention Research (PrevLab), Department of Behavioral Disorders, Faculty of Education and Rehabilitation Sciences at the University of Zagreb, participates in the project **Further ENhancing the Implementation of Quality Standards in drug demand reduction across Europe (FENIQS-EU),** which started in 2021 and will last until 2023, 24 months. Three academic partners (Department of Special Needs Education at Ghent University, Charles University - 1st Faculty of Medicine, Department of Addictology, University of Zagreb - Faculty of Education and Rehabilitation Sciences, Department of Behavioral Disorders) and four pan-European DDR networks (IREFREA, Correlation C-EHRN, Euro-TC, EUFAS) are involved in the project. This project was funded by the European Union's Justice Programme — Drugs Policy Initiatives.

The general objective of this project is to enhance implementation of QS in drug prevention, treatment, and harm reduction throughout the EU. To realize the general objective, four specific objectives are central to the action:

- 1. Assess the current state of QS implementation in the EU
- 2. Study 'good' and promising practice examples of QS implementation
- 3. Translate 'good' practice examples into an implementation toolkit and test it in various real-world contexts
- 4. Spread the lessons learnt and train stakeholders from across the EU.
